### CHOOSING OPTIONS

As you will be aware your son is about to embark on the GCSE options process leading to a decision on which subjects he will study in Key Stage 4 (Years 10 and 11). The process is due to begin during week commencing **6<sup>th</sup> February** with boys starting to work on their option choices with their Tutors and accessing the school website for information. Half term week will be an ideal time to reflect on and develop these thoughts.

On **Thursday 9<sup>th</sup> February** there will be an Information Evening for parents and students. There will be two presentations in the School Hall, the first at 6.00pm for parents and students of C, D and M Houses, the second at 7.00pm for parents and students in R, T and W Houses. Upon arrival you will receive an Options Booklet providing information on each subject choice. There will be a presentation giving an overview of the options structure at TBSHS (i.e. compulsory and optional subjects).

To ease the flow of people, it would be helpful if you could arrive just before the start of the appropriate presentation. Students should attend in school uniform. Students will be encouraged to ask questions of their subject teachers prior to making their decisions. Final choices must be submitted by **Friday 24<sup>th</sup> March** allowing a full seven weeks for decision making.
