Careers Forum 24th October 2018 5pm-7pm

The Bishop's Stortford High School are pleased to invite you to the School's biennial Careers Forum taking place on **Wednesday 24th October 2018** in the school hall.

The event is designed to give students some insight into the careers available and allow them to ask questions and gain information from professionals. Exhibitors can give guidance on A-level options plus advice on careers, further/higher education choices, entry requirements, professional and craft careers. The evening will provide the perfect opportunity to help our students begin to develop their ideas about higher education or employment and to make important choices about their futures after their A-Levels or after graduating from University. This event would also be particularly useful for any sixth form students who may have a particular career in mind or are not applying to university. **All students are expected to attend and must be in their school uniform.**

We currently have over fifty-five professions represented including law, insurance, veterinary, accountancy, architecture, pharmacy, medicine, engineering, web design/marketing, surveying and physiotherapy. All of the armed services will be present plus nationwide recruitment companies such as GSK, Deloitte, Raytheon Systems UK and the Civil Service along with companies who specialise in apprenticeship pathways. Many local companies will be present as well as higher education establishments such as the University of Hertfordshire; it promises to be a busy and stimulating evening.

Exhibitors will be available on an individual basis and due to the large number of students invited, the evening will be staggered, therefore **Year 12 are invited to attend between 5pm-6pm and Year 13 between 6pm-7pm.**

It is likely to be a very busy evening and if arriving by car, you may find it helpful to park in the surrounding residential area rather than on the school site.
