



MODULES/UNITS IN YEAR 9

AUTUMN TERM/SPRING TERM

German Expressionism Project | Drawing, Lino Printing, Painting and or Oil Pastel

Knowledge of the assessment objectives will be developed.
 Research, analysis, transcriptions will be done in sketchbooks.
 Students will explore a range of different materials and develop ideas independently.
 Observational drawing will inform Lino cutting.
 Health and Safety aspects when cutting and printing will be understood.
 Students will have an extended period of sustained work on a final piece around these themes resulting in a refined final piece.

SUMMER TERM

Roy Lichtenstein & Mondrian Project

Students will explore the work of Piet Mondrian and Roy Lichtenstein looking at the differences and similarities between the two artists. Students will explore different mark making techniques and compositional ideas leading towards a large scale final piece. Students will be expected to use the techniques explored to independently create their own outcomes around theme.

MODULES/UNITS IN YEAR 10

AUTUMN TERM

Still Life

Students will be developing their work ready for the mock examination by looking at a variety of artists who paint still life.
 The artists will be very different in terms of style. This will encourage students to work in a particular way and understand process and style.
 Students will be introduced to a range of different mixed media approaches and will be encouraged to use their observational work as a starting point for abstraction and personalization of outcomes.

SPRING TERM/SUMMER TERM

Students will work from a specimen AQA exam paper and develop work independently on their chosen theme. This will lead onto their mock exams where they will be expected to use this exploration to create their own personalized outcome.

Structure and Light Project

Students use observational drawing as a starting point for developing abstract sculptural forms in the style of Picasso.
 Students will explore tone and Light through photography. This work will inform large scale sculptures using plaster and card.
